



# Adhkar after Salah | الأذكار بعد الصلاة | (Supplications after Prayer)

Recite after *tasleem*. 3 times:

أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ 3x

I ask Allaah for forgiveness.

'Astaghfirullaaha

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ السَّلَامُ، وَمِنْكَ السَّلَامُ، تَبَارَكْتَ يَا ذَا الْجَلَالِ وَالْإِكْرَامِ

O Allaah, You are Peace and from You comes peace. Blessed are You, O Owner of majesty and honor.

Allaahumma 'Antas-Salaamu wa minkas-salaamu, tabaarakta yaa Thal-Jalaali wal-'Ikraam

# Adhkar after Salah | الأذكار بعد الصلاة | (Supplications after Prayer)

Whoever says these after every prayer will be forgiven his sins even though they be as the foam of the sea.

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ 33x ، الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ 33x ، اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ 33x ،

How perfect Allaah is, all praise is for Allaah, and Allaah is the greatest.

*Subhaanallaahi, walhamdu lillaahi wallaahu 'Akbar,*

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ ، وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ . 1x

None has the right to be worshipped except Allaah, alone, without any partner, to Him belong all sovereignty and praise and He is over all things omnipotent.

Ayatul Kursi - Surah Al Baqarah (2:255).

اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ الْحَيُّ الْقَيُّومُ... (آية الكرسي)

Whoever recites Aayat al-Kursiy immediately after each prescribed prayer, there will be nothing standing between him and his entering Paradise except death.

The following three Surahs should be recited once after Zuhr, 'Asr and 'Ishaa prayers and thrice after the Fajr and Maghrib prayers.

سُورَةُ الْإِخْلَاصِ - سُورَةُ الْفَلَقِ - سُورَةُ النَّاسِ

*Surah al-Ikhlaas (112), Surah al-Falaq (113), Surah al-Naas (114)*

[Tirmidhi]

Recite after the FAJR Prayer | بعد الفجر

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ عِلْمًا نَافِعًا ، وَرِزْقًا طَيِّبًا ، وَعَمَلًا مُتَقَبَّلًا .

O Allah, I ask You for knowledge that is of benefit, a good provision, and deeds that will be accepted.

*Allaahumma 'innee 'as'aluka 'ilman naafi'an, wa rizqan tayyiban, wa 'amalan mutaqabbalan.*

Recite 10 times after the MAGHRIB and FAJR Prayers | بعد الفجر والمغرب

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ ، يُحْيِي وَيُمِيتُ

وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ . 10x

None has the right to be worshipped but Allaah alone, Who has no partner. His is the dominion and His is the praise. He brings life and He causes death, and He is Able to do all things.

*Laa 'ilaaha 'illallaahu wahdahu laa shareeka lahu, lahul-mulku wa lahul-hamdu yuhyee wa yumeetu wa Huwa 'alaa kulli shay'in Qadeer.*
